In Part 1:

- Meg 16, "plump and fair, with plenty of soft, brown hair, a sweet mouth and white hands"
- Jo 15, "very tall, thin, and brown", "a decided mouth, a comical nose, and sharp, grey eyes", "her long, thick hair was her one beauty...usually bundled into a net, to be out of her way", "round shoulders", "big hands and feet, a flyaway look to her clothes"
- **Beth** 13, "rosy, smooth-haired, brighteyed"
- Amy 12, "a regular snow maiden, with blue eyes, and yellow hair curling on her shoulders, pale and slender"

In Part 2, after 4 years have passed:

- Meg 20, "looked very like a rose herself, for all that was best and sweetest in heart seemed to bloom into her face...making it fair and tender", "braided up her pretty hair"
- Jo 19, "Jo's angles are much softened",
 "the curly crop has lengthened into a thick coil, more becoming to the small head atop the tall figure", "fresh color in her brown cheeks"
- **Beth** 17, "grown slender, pale, and more quiet than ever; the beautiful, kind eyes are larger"
- Amy 16, "has the air and bearing of a full-grown woman – not beautiful, but possessed of that indescribable charm called grace", "her wonderfully fair complexion, keen blue eyes, and curls more golden and abundant than ever"
