### What is Morality?

\_\_\_\_\_ : making judgment calls about what is right or wrong, or good or bad behavior.

\_\_\_\_\_ : another word for an individual person's morals.

- \_\_\_\_\_ : good/right behavior
- \_\_\_\_\_ : bad/wrong behavior
- \_\_\_\_\_ : not moral or immoral; doesn't have a right/wrong
