

Poetry Booklet Instructions

Please note: Your poetry booklets are meant to be seen by your parents. They should look nice. We will be using class craft supplies tomorrow – but you are welcome to take your booklet home to work on it if you'd like.

1. Pick a title for your poetry booklet, and design the cover. Put the title on your title page.
2. Decide the pages where you will put each poem and create your Table of Contents.
 - Check that you have your:
 - Onomatopoeia Poem
 - Alliteration Poem
 - Sonnet
 - Class Haiku
 - Personal Haiku
 - Shape/Concrete Poem
 - Idioms Poem
 - Hyperbole Couplet
 - Analogy/Metaphor/Simile Poem
3. Copy your poems onto the pages you have selected **in pencil**.
 - Your handwriting needs to be **legible** and **neat**.
 - After you have copied it in pencil, and it looks nice, you may go over your letters with pen.
4. Add at least two illustrations. Your Shape/Concrete Poem does NOT count as an illustration.
 - You do not need to draw these. If you prefer to print out an illustration and color it nicely, you may do so – however, you can't print the pictures in class.
